Care Allowance & Moving: What You Need to Know

What Is a Care Allowance?

A care allowance (*Pflegegeld*) is financial support provided to individuals requiring long-term care. In Germany, this is administered through statutory long-term care insurance (*Pflegeversicherung*). In certain circumstances, this allowance can help fund relocation to a more suitable living arrangement — such as moving closer to family or into assisted living.

Can You Transfer It When Moving?

Yes — care allowances can typically be transferred when relocating within Germany. However, it is essential to notify your care insurance provider well in advance of your move. This ensures your benefits continue without interruption and that any new care arrangements are properly registered and covered.

- ✔ Notify your provider at least 4–6 weeks before your moving date to avoid any gaps in coverage.

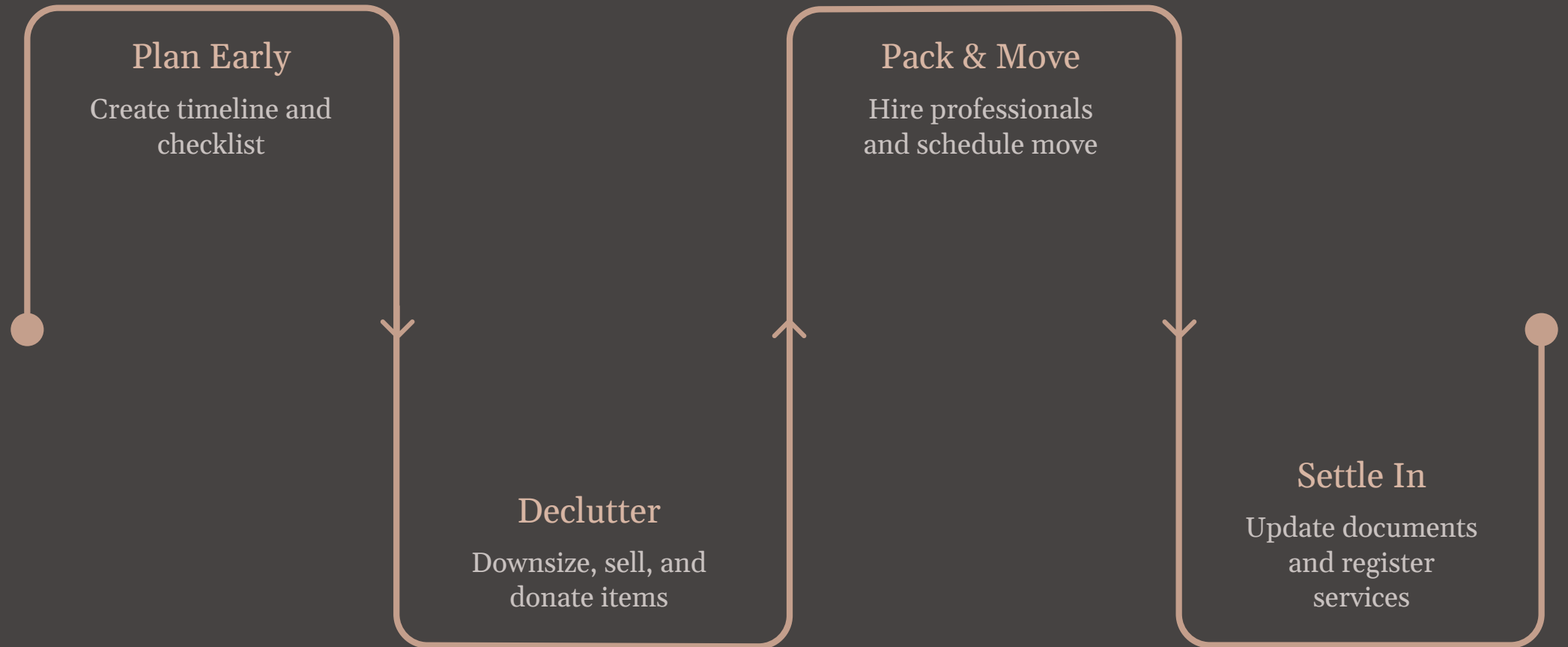

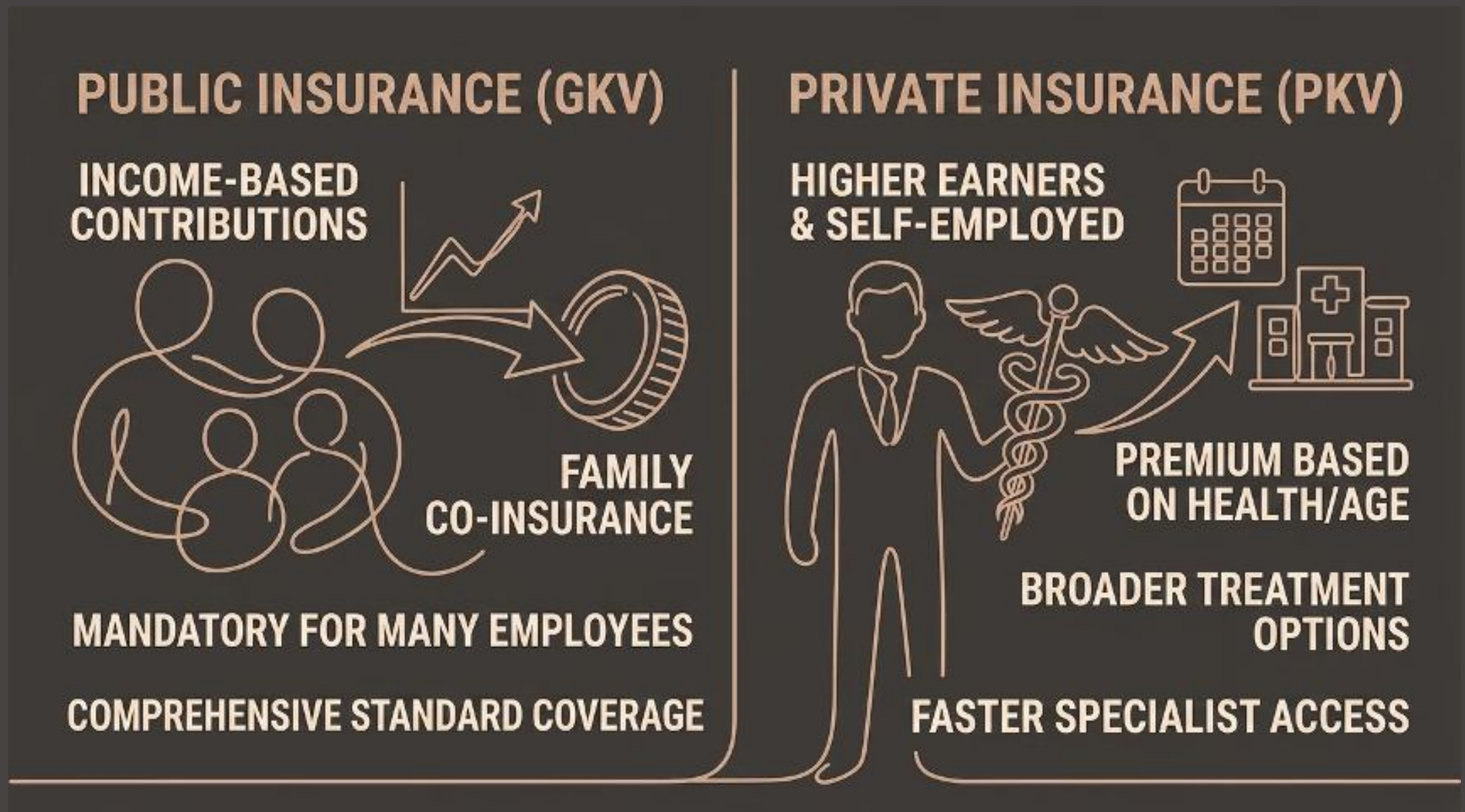
Private Insurance (PKV)

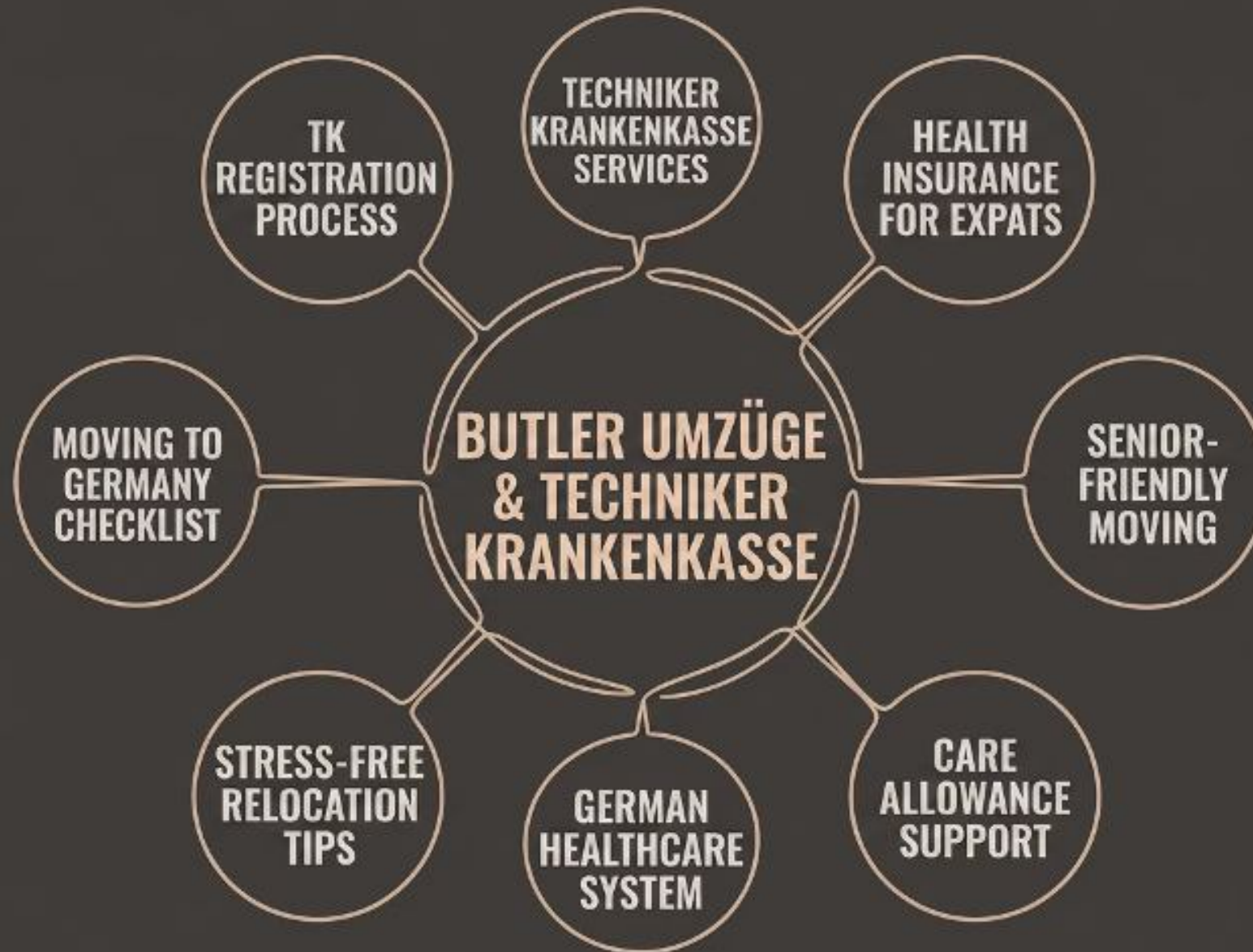
